ADMINISTRATION:

Method of Use / Application

Ensure the teats, udder and milker's hands are washed clean and then dried with a clean milking cloth before using BIMEDA MILKING SALVE.

DOSAGE:

Use quantities to achieve sufficient level of lubrication.

Hand Milking:

Apply BIMEDA MILKING SALVE on hands and massage onto the teats before and after milking for lubrication and to prevent chapping of teats.

Machine Milking:

Apply BIMEDA MILKING SALVE on the teats before inserting the teat cups. Milk normally and apply the salve on the teats again after milking.

STORAGE:

Store below 30⁰C.
